

# Fr. Bob's Weekly Blog

## Welcome to the Parish of St. Symphorosa & St. Rene!!

Monsignor Thomas Richter approached the podium. After some initial introductory remarks, he spoke words that immediately captured everyone's attention.

"The secret to life is ..." he said. Everyone waited for what words of wisdom came next. "The secret to life is a heart that knows how to receive from God." He repeated the key phrase. The priest had listeners hooked.

Why? Because so many of us want to know the secret to life. Think about it. How many books or videos are sold each year promising to provide the consumer with some special approach to life that is going to make all the difference.

Need proof? Author Rhonda Byrne wrote a book called "The Secret," and it has sold over 30 million copies and it has been translated into 50 languages. Christian author Rick Warren sold 35 million copies of his best-seller "The Purpose Driven Life" and the book has been translated into 70 different languages.

These books sell because we are searching for the secret and for life's purpose.

And yet, Monsignor Richter sums it all up so succinctly. "The secret to life is a heart that knows how to receive from God." The Lord has much He desires to give us but far too often our heart is not receptive. Msgr. Richter spoke these words at the 2016 THIRST conference for the Diocese of Bismarck, North Dakota.

Today's Gospel is the Parable of God's mercy this way. Many folks see God as a competitor, and as a parable is an earthly story about a result play a game of win or lose, heavenly reality. God desires to instead of embracing the win-win give us divine grace (an unmerited gift). We know there are widely differing responses in people to receiving God's grace.

What Jesus is saying in the Parable of the Sower emphasizes a human being's responsibility to be ready to accept God's grace and to respond to it.

This well-known parable is a wonderful illustration of how important the disposition of our heart is when it comes to receiving – or not receiving – from God. God gives grace, and man freely responds to that grace. The result is that those who respond to grace generously receive additional grace and so grow steadily in grace and holiness; whereas those who reject God's gifts become closed up within themselves; through their selfishness and attachment to sin they eventually lose God's grace entirely.

God didn't take away the grace. The unrepentant person gave it away or refused it.

The secret to life is a heart that knows how to RECEIVE from God.

This may come as a surprise to some folks, but God desires to give of Himself in abundance. In John's Gospel (10:10) Jesus says, "A thief comes only to steal and slaughter and destroy; I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly."

Sadly, we far too often don't view

the Sower. We are reminded that a parable is an earthly story about a result play a game of win or lose, heavenly reality. God desires to instead of embracing the win-win give us divine grace (an unmerited gift). We know there are widely differing responses in people to receiving God's grace.

What Jesus is saying in the Parable of the Sower emphasizes a human being's responsibility to be ready to accept God's grace and to respond to it.

The Father sent Son into fallen humanity to redeem it and bring it back toward Home. Jesus is the Gift given to us by the Father. He is the Word made flesh that dwelt among us. Christ did not intend for the Good News to be a secret. He gives us (yes, us today) the same Great Commission He gave his apostles.

Jesus says, "Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations."

The Word of God must be sprinkled over the earth. And this sowing of salvific seed must first take deep root in each of our hearts. How deep have you received God's love for you?

If there are days you doubt God's love for you, go sit for fifteen minutes in front of a crucifix. Look up and see those wide-open arms, and hear the Lord say to you, "I love you this much."

There's no secret. There's simply Jesus.



# MASS TIME CHANGE

One of the realities of the newly unified parish of St. Symphorosa & St. Rene is the necessity for a new Mass schedule. Changing Mass times can be one of the most stressful things we experience in parish life. A pastor and his advisors should only make adjustments to a Mass schedule if it is absolutely a must.

Well, the new parish reality makes the altering of the Mass times a must.

Beginning on July 1st, 8am daily Masses will be alternating each month between the two worship sites. In July, daily Mass will be celebrated at 8am at St. Rene Church. In August, 8am daily Mass will be celebrated at St. Symphorosa Church. Please look in the Mass Intentions portion of the bulletin to be sure of which worship site Mass will be celebrated.

The new Sunday Mass schedule begins on the weekend of July 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>. Please make sure the new Mass times are in a convenient place in your home for reference purposes.

To those folks for whom this change causes great angst or anger, please accept my apology and know I understand. But a pastor has to make decision based on the well-being of the entire parish, not just certain individuals. But, yes, I get it. It will take time to adjust, but we'll walk this road of transition together united by the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

As a new parish, we have two options as far as worship site is concerned. Parishioners can participate in Holy Mass at both the St. Symphorosa and St. Rene church buildings. As pastor, I encourage you to make use of both locations depending on what Mass time works for you on a given weekend.

My dream is that in a few years we need to ADD Masses because our pews are full. Right now, that is not the case. Jesus gave us a mission, and this mission prompts us to go, make disciples, baptize and teach. And this is what we'll be doing in the years to come. It's both an exciting time but also challenging. We need one another now more than ever.

# CHURCH REOPENING GUIDELINES

As we progress, we have been given strict guidelines that **MUST** be followed from the Archdiocese of Chicago. The guidelines briefly listed below are for confessions, private prayer and public Masses. Please contact the parish office (773.767.1523) for more information or if you have any questions in regards to the guidelines. Also, please contact the Parish Office if you or someone you know is interested in volunteering to join our Reopening Team.

## **Mass - Attendance Capacity Restricted to under 20% - Social Distancing**


- All Mass worshippers **MUST Pre-register** for a reserved slot, indicating # of attendees (either by changing the quantity or noting the comment sections) and including your first and last name. **If you miss the opportunity to pre-register for Mass you may still come to church and register upon arrival.**
  - Pre-register via a link provided on our parish website and social media or calling the Parish Office (773) 767-1523.
  - Pre-registration for weekend Masses opens at Wednesday morning prior to the weekend. Registration will stay open through 12pm (noon) Saturday.
- Please arrive at least **15 minutes** before the start of Mass.
- Upon arrival – (**wearing a mask**) check in with a Greeter for seating assignment.
- While not recommended, if you have not pre-registered last minute space **MAY** be available which would allow late registration on the day of Mass.
- Please be understanding, patient, and courteous throughout this process.

**PLEASE NOTE: Dispensation from Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation continues. It is still advised that the elderly and those with underlying medical conditions stay at home and participate through livestreamed and televised Masses. If you are feeling ill or have a temperature please do not come to church.**

## **Guidelines for Confession, Private Prayer & Public Mass Attendance**

- Everyone entering the church **MUST** wear face masks the entire time, whether during confession, private prayer or Mass! Hand sanitizer will be provided by the parish and **MUST** be used upon entering the church.
- Trained Greeters will monitor entry, ensure social distancing & direct to appropriate seating.
- Pews and floor will have markings to designate waiting lines, seating, etc. to maintain social distancing

Once again, we are all learning... please be mindful of these guidelines for the safety of yourself and all those around you. We ask for patience and respect towards our greeters and those within our Re-opening Leadership team as they navigate through the first few weeks of this process. We look forward to this opportunity, not only to see some familiar faces again, but to be able to share the Eucharist and worship together within our Catholic faith tradition.




