This was the third annual readathon with a goal of

35,000 pages to be read and a monetary goal of \$3,000 to be raised. The readathon this year ran from April 29th thru May 15th. Our entire school participated in this event

surpassing the pages goal, finishing at 36,325 pages read. The school fell
