# Fr. Bob's Weekly Blog



"Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by every joint with which it is supplied, when each part is working properly, makes bodily growth and upbuilds itself in love." Ephesians 15: 15-16

At any given moment in time, we are either moving closer to God or away from God. There is no standing still when it comes to the spiritual life.

The famous quote by Samuel Smiles gives us food for thought. He wrote, "Sow a thought, and you reap an act; Sow an act, and you reap a habit; Sow a habit and you reap a character; Sow a character and you reap a destiny."

The little things we do each and every day matter; sometimes small things that seem rather insignificant, but when added up, make a huge difference in the great scheme of things. Using a sports analogy, everybody on the football team wants to make it to the end zone, but the journey to the end zone consists of proper blocks being made, running the ball effectively, making snap passes, and being disciplined enough not to jump off-side.

One of the beloved spiritual directors at Mundelein Seminary used to strongly encourage his directees, as soon as they woke up in the morning, to make the Sign of the Cross, and then make their bed. This, he believed, got the day off to a proper start by acknowledging God and then making sure when you come back at night, you had a nicely-made bed to sleep in.

Christian discipleship is about being disciplined in the ways of Jesus, He who is the Way, and the

Truth, and the Life. Growth seldom occurs during "easy times." If we're being honest, we'd say we learned more about life after undergoing tough times. Just as our physical muscles are strengthened by resistance, so too are our spiritual muscles strengthened by denying what we want and surrendering to what God wants from us. Being a Christian means saying "yes" to God and "no" to anything that pulls away from God.

Pay attention to your thoughts, because your thoughts soon become your actions, and what you do over and over again becomes a habit; this affects who you are as a person, and this, in turn, has a direct effect on your eternal destiny.

The narrow gate is the Way of Jesus. The wide gate is the way of the world. God gives us the freedom to walk through either one. May the choices we make today lead us closer to God, which, in reality, brings us closer to others.


