Welcome to Two Holy Martyrs Parish!!

St. Symphorosa & St. Rene Goupil

My dad rarely spoke about his World War II experience.

Occasionally he'd let out some of the less emotional stuff but never did I personally hear him get into any war-time detail about his service in China.

Prior to his departure to the Far East, he was enrolled as a student at the University of Wisconsin-Madison where he also played football and baseball. After his sophomore year he and many of his teammates entered various branches of the United States military and, accordingly, were sent all over the globe.

A couple years later, as the men came back to the Madison, Wisconsin campus, they realized some of their teammates did not come home. They had died in battle; they gave their lives in service to the country and in the name of freedom.

Later in life, when my dad would be asked if he was interested in an overseas vacation, he'd reply, "No, thanks. I already took my overseas vacation." Dad never left the country again. His war experience changed him and helped him maintain perspective as he became a high school football coach and Dean of Students for the Morton (Berwyn-Cicero) School District.

The way he approached sports rubbed off on me. Sports is NOT war. Sports is NOT a battle. When I spent some years as a sports writer I made sure to NEVER refer to any sporting event I covered as a war, battle, or blitzkrieg. Too many men and women have died in real wars to cheapen their sacrifice by referring to a mere game as war.

As we celebrate Memorial Day, please honor all the men and women who have given their lives in service to our country and for freedom. As the saying goes, "Freedom is not free." Those people who have fought in wars never want another war. They have learned first-hand the brutality of war. Sadly, there are those among us who seem to relish the rattling of sabers as a way to acquire land and/or power. Troubled punks start wars, but heroes will arise to finish them just as saints arise during times of persecution.

Mass as Memorial

Every time we participate in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, we remember. We look back in time so that – with faith, hope and charity – we can look forward to eternal life.

Each Mass is Memorial Day. We call to mind (remember) when Jesus gave His life in the great spiritual battle. The crucifix serves as a constant reminder that our freedom from sin, evil and death was purchased by the Blood of the Lamb. Those outstretched arms nailed to the wood of the cross speak to us through the centuries, "I love you this much."

Someone might say "Mass is boring." Well, someone might

also say "Arlington National Cemetery is boring," but it could only be boring because we've forgotten or never learned the story of those who fought in war and died so that others could live in freedom. What took place at Normandy is far from boring, and what took place on Good Friday is far from boring.

Jesus died on the cross, and every single Mass for the past 2,000 years is a re-presentation in time and space of that SAME sacrificial act FOR US. At Mass, we find ourselves at the foot of the cross, and gathered around the table of the Last Supper.

"This is my Body given *FOR YOU*."

Nothing boring about love – a love that goes all the way to the cross so that we can be pulled through the cross into the glory of God (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit).

When we begin to see our faith this way, it is life-changing, and the more people see the faith this way, it then becomes world-changing and culture-changing.

What should be our response to Jesus' sacrificial act? We echo back to Him the same words, "This is my body give for you, Lord." We live our lives for the greater glory of God.

The late Bishop Fulton J. Sheen said it this way, "You have freedom only to give (your heart) away. To whom do you give yours? You give it either to the moods, to the hour, to your egotism, to creatures, or to God."

Last Friday we said farewell to our parish school graduating class of 2021.

These young disciples and students will enjoy summer and then embark on their high school years. Please keep them in your prayers. They are growing up in a confused culture that wants to come across as life-enhancing but is, in far too many ways, life-draining.

We wish these children well, and pray them well. Their final two years of grade school were far from normal. Their day-to-day lives were challenging as they faced all the COVID guidelines put in place for safety and health reasons. They have been amazing through it all.

Thank you to our principal Kathy Berry, all the teachers and aides, for making their school experience the best it could be.



May this light which reminds us of Jesus' presence in the Tabernacle help welcome our prayers into His eternal presence.



“And behold, I [Jesus] am with you always, until the end of the age.” (Matthew 28:20)

“God our Father, who by sending into the world the Word of truth and the Spirit of sanctification made known to the human race your wondrous mystery, grant us, we pray, that in professing the true faith, we may acknowledge the Trinity of eternal glory and adore your Unity, powerful in majesty,” (Roman Missal, 3rd ed.) so prays the Church on this Sunday as we explicitly worship the Most Holy Trinity. Now, the Holy Trinity is not any more three and one on this Sunday than on any other day and the Catholic Church prays to the Holy Trinity, three divine persons, one God, every day, not only on this Sunday. After much emphasis during the past couple of months on the earthly life of Jesus through His Passion, Death, Resurrection and Ascension, followed by a shift in our attention toward the Holy Spirit’s coming at that original Pentecost in the life of the Church, we return to the “oneness” of God, which is every bit as real and true as God’s “threeness,” if I may use such a word.

God being three and one simultaneously remains one of the mysterious dogmas of our faith, a fundamental and immutable teaching, which has already been revealed at Jesus’ Baptism but is crafted into a formal teaching and profession of faith over the course of several centuries in the early Church. Believing that the Holy Trinity is *both* one God *and* three divine persons at the same time is a matter of faith and revelation on par with the Church’s belief and teaching that Jesus is *both* fully God *and* fully man at the same time.

How do we respond to these mysteries of faith, which on the surface sound contradictory: one and three are different numbers; God and man are different natures? God, knowing this challenge to believe, reveals a couple ways of responding to Him. From the Book of Deuteronomy, the source of the First Reading, Moses challenges his fellow Israelites to think on the marvels of creation, which exceed human power to invent. Then, Moses reminds the large mass of people to think back on how God has freed them from slavery in Egypt, an extraordinarily personal encounter with God. Thinking on the big categories of life and being can feel daunting. Even with all that has been discovered much remains unknown, a mystery. Thinking on how we have encountered God and what He has done for us, perhaps manifested through certain experiences or through other people, might be a more accessible and engaging opportunity for slowly coming to know the Holy Trinity rather than solving the mystery of God’s “oneness” and “threeness.”

St. Paul reassures us of why we may approach the Holy Trinity: “For those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received a Spirit of adoption, through whom we cry, ‘Abba, Father!’ The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God.” (Romans 8:15-16) Do you believe that you are a daughter or son of God? Do you respond to God in light of this truth, “a Spirit of adoption”? Without diminishing any of the three divine persons, have you felt that one of the three, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, is more relatable than the other two (this sense of relatability can change over time)?


