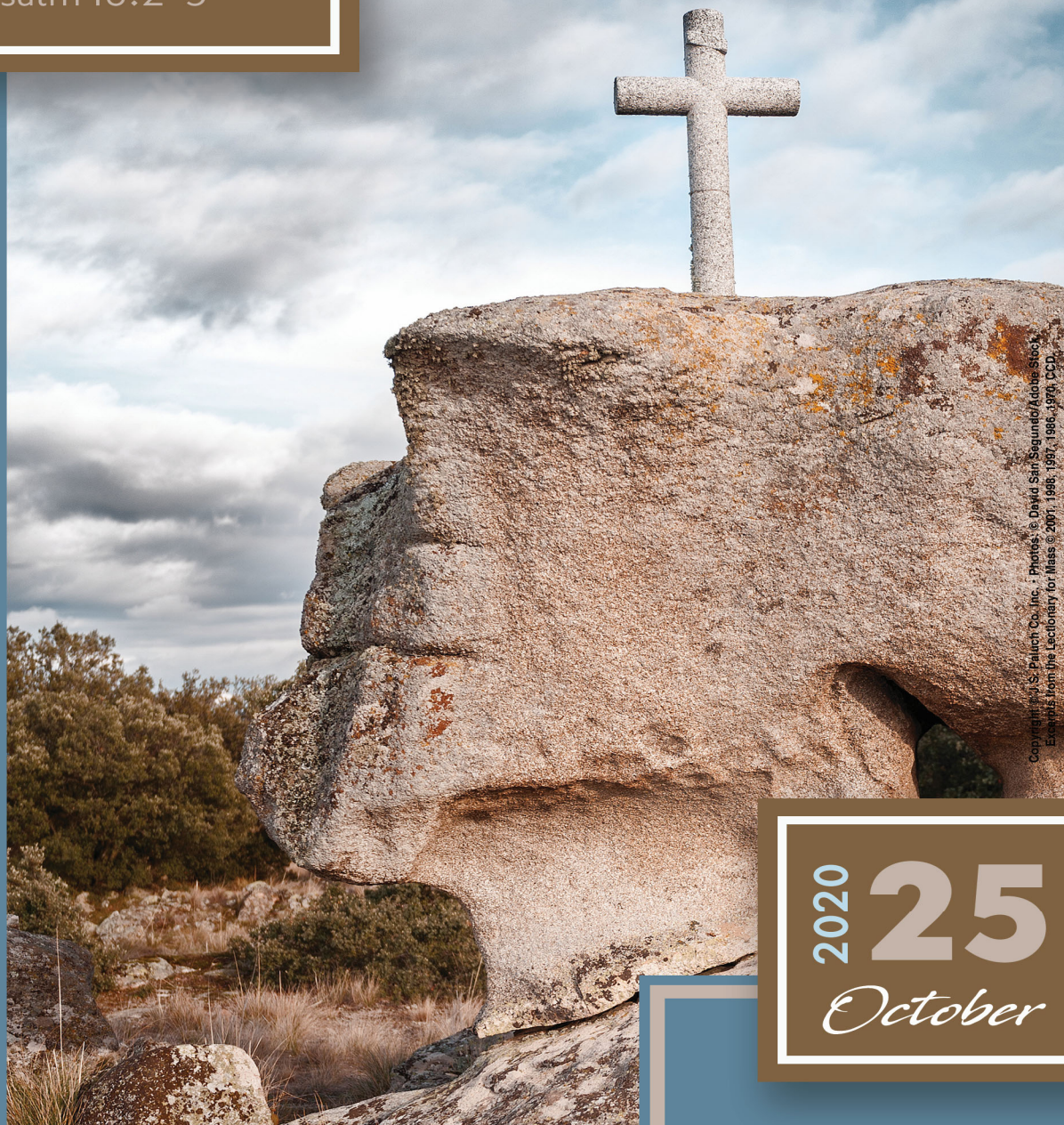

Fr. Bob's Weekly Blog

Welcome to the Parish of St. Symphorosa & St. Rene!!

God shows us what Love looks like in the Person of Jesus, the Christ.

We look to Jesus to learn about love, and to learn how to love. This is why the four Gospels are so important for us to read. And not only read, but to spend time praying with them and reflecting on how we have received this love, and how we are sharing this love.

The entirety of our lives is a gradual conforming to Christ. We become little Christs, thanks be to God's grace. To think we do this with our own human power alone is wishful thinking. We need God – a power outside ourselves – the way a person sinking in quicksand needs a rescuer outside the danger to assist in the recovery.

We must realize how important the Holy Spirit is in our day-to-day quest to receive God's love and live this love out in the ordinariness of life. A good way to be INSPIRED to love as God loves is to ask consistently for the Holy Spirit to fill your heart.

"Come Holy Spirit. Fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And you shall renew the face of the earth."

The Father has shown us the Way, and the Truth and the Life by way of His Son. Why do so many people seem to want to find a different route to Love?

C.S. Lewis wrote, "All that we call human history – money, power, ambition, war, prostitution, classes, empires, slavery – is the long terrible story of man trying to find something other than God which will make him happy."

Well said, Mr. Lewis. Perhaps one of the advantages of straying from the faith to explore dark alleys is that we learn (hopefully before it's too late) authentic love and real intimacy can't be found by separating ourselves from

God. We begin to see more clearly what it is we do not want and to see more clearly what it is we want.

Our society gets far too easily distracted from what really matters. We run the risk of getting lost in the superficial and fake. We even start to think we can "do church" without the Holy Spirit. We fall for the bumper sticker slogan of the day instead of resting in the eternal truth of Christ. St. Paul reminds us in Hebrews, chapter eight, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever. Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teaching."

Like rebellious children, we are tempted to run away from Home only to find the grass isn't always greener "over there." We eventually learn that the grass is greener where we nurture God's love in worship to our Creator and in service to neighbor.

Jesus beautifully brings together this wisdom in our Gospel this weekend. He says, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. The second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

Jesus wonderfully shows us the two are directly related. We can't say we love God and then leave Mass only to shout vulgar profanities at the person who cut us off in traffic, or to go home and emotional or physically abuse family members. We also can't make ourselves feel good by claiming "Love is love" and yet cut God (who is Love) out of the picture, as we settle for a love of our own making.

Spend some time reflecting on St. Thomas Aquinas' definition of love ... "Love is willing the good of the other, as other." This means we truly want what is best for another person without any strings attached.

How would you define love? Go ahead and think about that and then write it down. If you need someone to help you, look to Jesus and ask the Holy Spirit to inspire you. Love is not merely a feeling or warm fuzzy. Love is a choice. May we choose wisely every single day until Love calls us Home.

Saints and Souls

Next Sunday is All Saints Day. This year it falls on a Sunday so we will follow the regular weekend schedule.

This celebration reminds us of our call to be saints. Leon Bloy once said that the only real tragedy in life is not to be a saint. If we aspire to heaven then we aspire to be a saint. This ties in to the universal call to holiness. The great lie of the Enemy is to make us think this is impossible or foolish. Don't believe the lie. With God, all things are possible.

We honor our saints throughout the ages who serve a spiritual role models in the story of salvation.

On Monday, November 2, we will celebrate All Souls Day. This is NOT a Holy Day of Obligation, but it is a special day when we pray for our beloved dead.

There will be three (3) celebrations of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on All Souls Day: 8 AM at the St. Rene church, 7 PM at the St. Symphorosa church, and 7 PM at the St. Rene Church. The evening Masses will specifically remember those who have died in the past year within our parish.

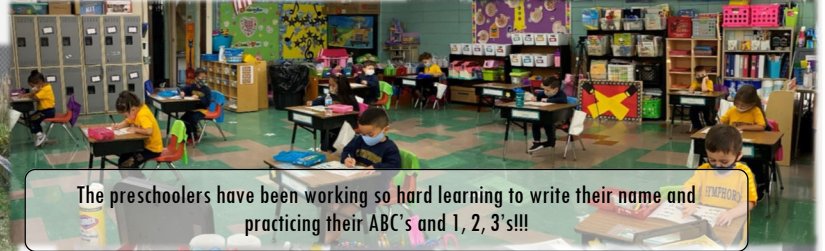

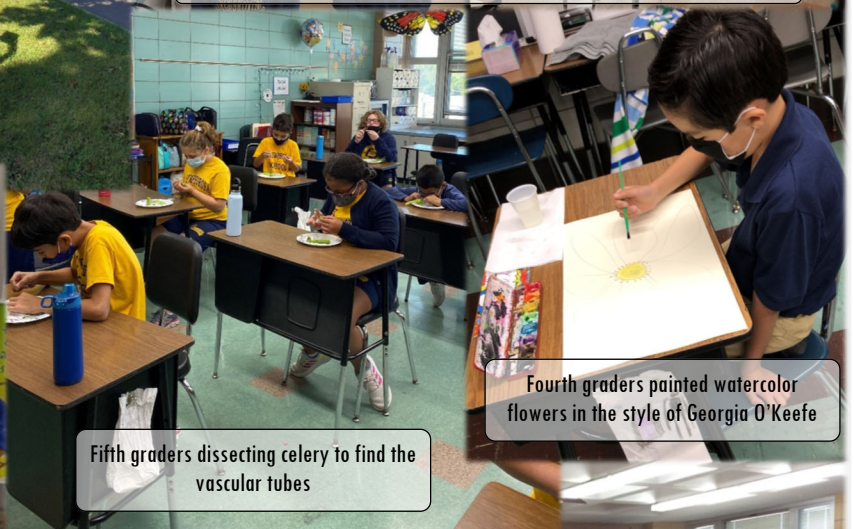
