As a Family Celebrating Faith, the parish family of St. Symphorosa welcomes fellow Christians and renews the commitment to our faith in Communion with Christ.


At St. Symphorosa Parish, we strive to live our membership in God's Family by:

#### Survey Highlights


- "Our church needs to be more vibrant and a center of activity"
- "St. Symphorosa has to promote the sense of community! We need to see each other outside of Sunday masses to form bonds and friendships with our neighbors."
- "Our church needs to develop its' identity and do more to excite the parishioners. Activities like Sunday afternoon movies, Bingo, social gatherings, etc."
- "More energy."

#### Survey Highlights

- "If we don't know what is needed, how can we help? Let us know what needs to be done."
- "Consider putting a removable calendar in the Sunday bulletin each month. It can be an activity reminder for the month"
- "We need more activities and opportunities. You won't bring in people unless you have something to entice them. Pick up the paper in the city or suburbs and there are tons of activities at churches."
- "At least two specially arranged masses/blessings with oil for handicapped people"
- Can we have a Spanish Mass? What about celebrations to honor our Lady of Guadalupe and Our Lady of Czestochowa?

#### Post Survey – January/February, 2016

- Changed meeting dates from monthly to bi-weekly
- Formed subgroups to brainstorm ideas for 2016
- Formulated calendar of events for March December, 2016
