Fr. Bob's Weekly Blog

Welcome to the Parish of St. Symphorosa & St. Rene!!

Mother Teresa gives us a warm Advent challenge.

This recently canonized saint said, "At this Christmas, when Christ comes, will he find a warm heart? Mark the season of Advent by loving and serving others with God's own love and concern."

We all run the risk of allowing our heart to grow cold by sin and indifference to God's love. Look around today and you can see the despair, the irreverence, the cynicism. We lose hope as more and more fellow human beings disappoint us by not meeting our expectations of "how things should be."

Instead of wallowing in the darkness we are encouraged to receive the Light that comes to us from the One who came into this world to die so that we might have life. Jesus is the Light of the world, and unless we welcome this light into our heart – into our very being – we cannot be a light for others.

Let's use the beginning of a new liturgical year to make a sincere re-commitment to the Lord. Perhaps we've gotten spiritually sloppy. Maybe we've turned our worship of God into thoughtless routine instead of it being reverent ritual. The beauty of it all is that we can always start anew by humbly voicing, "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the Living God, have mercy on me a sinner."

Humility enables us to see the miraculous possibility of the infinite God dwindling into the infancy of Jesus in Bethlehem. Pride can't see – or won't see – the beauty of a Creator entering into our brokenness in the flesh of a baby king.

C. S. Lewis wrote, "A proud man is

always looking down on things and people; and of course, as long as you are looking down you cannot see something that is above you."

The something that is above us is a Someone – The Trinitarian God that is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Our God is a divine relationship of love that explodes into the creation that we can sense. But there is a reality beyond time and space that we cannot scientifically measure with microscopes and telescopes. Instead, this invisible reality became visible in the manger of Bethlehem; and the Word became flesh and dwelt among us.

Advent is a time, once again, to prepare our hearts to receive the Lord. No matter where we might be in our relationship with Jesus, we can always be open to it deepening; becoming more mature. Part of this deepening is decluttering our heart of what needs to go. What in your heart might be blocking you for a much deeper joy that the Lord intends? Take time to sit down and be silent; examine where you are today. Be honest with the Lord. Pray that all that gets in the way of holiness may give way to the One who feeds us in both word and sacrament.

Avoid the secular rush to celebrate Christmas too soon. Stay present as these weeks of Advent go by and prepare the way of the Lord. Far too many of us are always looking toward tomorrow that we miss the presence of Christ found only in TODAY.

Stay awake. Stay present. Stay tuned. For no eye has seen, nor ear heard, what God has prepared for those who love Him.

Breaking Bread Hymnals

Every parish family is encouraged to take home a 2021 Breaking Bread Hymnal and make it your own.

In light of COVID-19 guidelines and concerns, we do NOT want to have the hymnals in the pews. Instead, we want each family (or you if you come to Mass alone) to have their own personal Breaking Bread hymnal.

You will then need to bring the hymnal with you EACH WEEK. Please, for now, **ONE** hymnal per family.

The hymnals can be picked up in the narthex. We ask that you sign your name that you take one, and that you use the white label on the hymnal to put your name, etc. There might be occasions when a hymnal gets left behind, etc., so please identify as yours.

These hymnals help us to prepare for Mass. The Sunday readings can be found inside along with our many hymns.

There is no cost for the initial Breaking Bread hymnal, but we may need to charge a small fee for second and third copies.

Thank you for your patience in all of this, and we hope this decision helps us be safe, but also worship our God with participatory joy. And remember, bring the hymnal with you each week.

**Domine, labia mea aperies
(Lord, you will open my lips) (Psalm 51:17)**

A guide for us as we enter this First Sunday of Advent, at prayer with the Church universal, and by extension, a guide to the entire liturgical season up to Christmas, is the Collect, the opening prayer for the Mass, which precedes the readings. The Collect for this First Sunday of Advent is as follows: "Grant your faithful, we pray, almighty God, the resolve to run forth to meet your Christ with righteous deeds at his coming, so that, gathered at his right hand, they may be worthy to possess the heavenly Kingdom. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever."

Fr. Adrian Nocent remarked about the potency and direction of this prayer for us as we set out in preparation to celebrate God's Incarnation and birth in Jesus the Christ in a new year of grace: "[Foremost] in the Church's mind is the expectation of the last day and the judgment that it will bring. The faithful must advance courageously to meet the Lord; they are called to enter into the kingdom of heaven at the judgment." (*The Liturgical Year: Advent, Christmas, Epiphany*, p. 107)

The tenor of this Collect might sound strange, more in line with what we just heard and prayed in November with the language about the end of time and judgment. As she nears the end of Advent, the Church will look back to Jesus' First Coming, His Nativity, but at the beginning of this season, she looks forward to our Lord's Second Coming, His return in glory, and forms us by prayer so that we may worthily meet Him.

The Collect for the Latin Mass, the Extraordinary Form of the Mass, for this same Sunday exhorts us to a similar hopeful alertness: "Stir up Thy power, we beseech Thee, O Lord, and come: that from the threatening dangers of our sins we may deserve to be rescued by Thy protection, and to be saved by Thy deliverance: Who livest and reignest with God the Father in the unity of the Holy Ghost God, world without end." (Translation, *The Daily Missal and Liturgical Manual*, Baronius Press, Ltd. 2007)

Fr. C. C. Martindale exhorts us to appreciate what this prayer conveys as we begin Advent: "But it is much if we recognise that the Church puts audacious words upon our lips. ... We ask Him to 'come.' Is God ever absent? No! But we are, on our side. Absent-minded. 'Out of sight, out of mind.' ... Come, therefore, Lord, come again, into our world, into my life." (*The Prayers of the Missal: I. The Sunday Collects*, p. 13)


