ST. SYMPHOROSA CHURCH REOPENING PLAN

We are pleased to announce that with the help of our Reopening Leadership Team, our beloved church will be reopening for Baptisms, Confessions, Weddings and Funerals. *Our current target date to reopen for public Masses is Saturday, June 13th at 5pm*. However, we will work slowly and carefully to ensure the safety of all those attending Mass and any other celebration within our church.

Saturday - June 6th 8:45 am - 9:30 am (Confession) 8:45 am - 10:00 am (Private Prayer) Monday - June 8th 8:45 am - 9:30 am (<u>Confession only</u>) Wed. - June 10th 8:45 am -10:00 am (Private Prayer)

As we progress, we have been given strict guidelines that <u>MUST</u> be followed from the Archdiocese of Chicago. The guidelines briefly listed below are for confessions, private prayer and public Masses. Please contact the parish office (773.767.1523) for more information or if you have any questions in regards to the guidelines. Also, please contact the Parish Office if you or someone you know is interested in volunteering to join our Reopening Team.

Mass - Attendance Capacity Restricted to under 20% - Social Distancing

- All Mass worshippers **MUST Pre-register** for a reserved slot, indicating # of attendees (either by changing the quantity or noting the comment sections) and including your first and last name.
 - ORegister via our parish website, social media or calling the Parish Office (773) 767-1523.
 - ORegistration for weekend Masses opens at 10am on the Wednesday prior to the weekend.
- Please arrive at least <u>15 minutes</u> before the start of Mass.
- Upon arrival (wearing a mask) check in with a Greeter for seating assignment.
- While not recommended, if you have not pre-registered..last minute space MAY be available which would allow late registration on the day of Mass.
- Please be understanding, patient, and courteous throughout this process.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Dispensation from Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation continues. It is still advised that the elderly and those with underlying medical conditions stay at home and participate through livestreamed and televised Masses. If you are feeling ill or have a temperature please do not come to church.

Guidelines for Confession, Private Prayer & Public Mass Attendance

- Everyone entering the church <u>MUST</u> wear face masks the entire time, whether during confession, private prayer or Mass! Hand sanitizer will be provided by the parish and MUST be used upon entering the church.
- Trained Greeters will monitor entry, ensure social distancing & direct to appropriate seating.
- Pews and floor will have markings to designate waiting lines, seating, etc. to maintain social distancing
- Only 10 worshippers for confessions and private prayer will be allowed within the church at any given time. Please be respectful of others who may be waiting to enter the church.
- If you have come for private prayer, please allow the Greeter to seat you and minimize further movement throughout the Church

Once again, we are all learning... please be mindful of these guidelines for the safety of yourself and all those around you. We ask for patience and respect towards our greeters and those within our Re-opening Leadership team as they navigate through the first few weeks of this process. We look forward to this opportunity, not only to see some familiar faces again, but to be able to share the Eucharist and worship together as a "Family Celebrating Faith" within our Catholic faith tradition.




Dearest Parishioners:






