Fr. Bob's Weekly Blog

Welcome to the Parish of St. Symphorosa & St. Rene!!

This is the time in the Church's One day when all things are should just stay as they are, and liturgical year that our Mass brought to fulfillment, our body they did so in one sentence. A real readings take on a more ominous, end-of-times theme.

The only ones who need to fear are those who boldly and consciously reject Jesus and His offer of Salvation. The Lord says, "Follow me." We have a choice. We can follow the Son of God. . . or not. Love does not coerce. If someone has to use threats, intimidation, and violence to advance their cause, we might do well to question their cause. Jesus' summons is one of love.

We as human beings consist of body and soul. We are material and spiritual. Our earthly body has an expiration date. We don't know that date, do we? But we have a date. The body will die but the soul lives on. The soul is immortal. Our hope is in the promise of Christ.



We ask of this through Christ our Lord, Amen.






