Fr. Bob's Weekly Blog

Welcome to the Parish of St. Symphorosa & St. Rene!!

C.S. Lewis regularly hit the nail on the proverbial head when he wrote.

Here's an example: "The Church exists for nothing else but to draw people into Christ, to make them little Christs. If they are not doing that, all the cathedrals, clergy, missions, sermons, even the Bible itself, are simply a waste of time."

Wow! Pretty blunt. However, Mr. Clive Staples Lewis points out the essential purpose of the Church in the world -- to sanctify us. Everything Jesus gives us in and through His Church is for the sake of holiness. We risk losing sight of this core principle when we look exclusively to the world and away from God.

Pick a hot button topic of the day. Imagine two people doing their best to have this discussion about said hot topic. One of the two persons is living a life of authentic discipleship and has a conscience formed in regular prayer and Church teaching. The other person does not believe in God and claims that issues of right and wrong are decided by the individual. Do we think they will see the hot button issue from the same perspective? Unlikely, because they are using a different lens through which to see the world we live in now.

This is why the reception of the Sacraments is so important for us as human beings. Jesus didn't leave us the seven sacraments so that we could dress up and take pictures before going out for a nice luncheon. No, he gave us the Sacraments as avenues of grace. This grace fills us with Christ's life, something we cannot do on our own. Something supernatural is taking place when the sacraments are celebrated. This is not magic, but it is a Mystery.

When a child is baptized, an indelible mark is left on his or her soul. This child has become a child of God and entered into the Christian family, all the while the stain of Original Sin is washed away. That is a WOW moment. We want to encourage everyone to have your

children baptized. Perhaps part of the growing darkness we are experiencing in the world is because we have neglected the sacraments, become indifferent to the sacraments, or simply don't believe in the sacraments. Children go unbaptized. The Eucharist is viewed as a mere symbol instead of the Body of Christ. Confession is feared or mocked, etc. etc.

Certainly, our COVID-19 restrictions have hampered our availability to receive the sacraments, and this saddens me. We were too quick to shut everything down and not find some way to still deliver the sacraments. People felt abandoned during a very scary time. If the Church isn't there for us during a dark time, then who will be? The Church did Her best to provide online options, but I am sorry, Mass through the TV screen is not the same. I remember presiding at Mass this past Pentecost Sunday, which happened to be the weekend the riots started in Chicago. As I read the Gospel that talked about the disciples hiding behind locked doors in fear, I couldn't help but realize our church doors were locked out of fear. The irony! People were scared and our doors were locked.

We cannot continue to live in fear. Time and time again in scripture we are told "Do not be afraid!" And yet how easy it is to begin to fear. We fear growing violence, hostile conversations, corrosive politics, contagious viruses and increasing godlessness. People need the Church, and we need to have our arms open to receive those who want to walk away from the daily dose of despair. People want hope, and God gives us all the hope we need in a Person -- Jesus the Christ. Stay close, stay hope filled, and stay tuned. God will deliver. He promised and God does not lie. There will be a Cross (so accept it) and there will be a Resurrection (prepare for it).

Three voices among us.

Since July 1, 2020, there have been three priests presiding at Mass between our parish's two worship sites.

There is a beauty in hearing three different voices, and three different homily styles. Fr. Norm, Fr. Matt and myself have done our best to mix up the Masses so that no one priest presides at one specific Mass. Fr. Norm is a retired priest in residence and brings a lifetime of wisdom to his preaching. Fr. Matt is a veteran of 16 years and shares his love for the liturgy. The pastor, interestingly enough, is the baby of the group, having been ordained only 5 years, but I will admit to a lifetime of learning experience on my way to the altar.

My hope is that you see this all as a gift. To have three priests in a parish today is almost a luxury. Do the people of God have favorites? Seems so, but I encourage all of us to recognize the humanity of each priest (we are wounded just like you) but also in the context of Holy Mass, to see the priest standing in the Person of Jesus Christ. Mass is prayer, not entertainment. We come to worship God and, in turn, to be sanctified. We come to Mass to get away from the ordinariness of the world, to step into the extraordinariness of the place where heaven and earth meet. This is a great gift, even if the Mass runs over an hour sometimes or the homily isn't up to your personal preference. You can tell God all about it someday.

Thank God for the gift of the Eucharist, and please, pray for more faith-filled young men to answer God's call. We also want to pray for young men and women to discern a call to religious life. Now is the time for us to step up and bring the light of Christ into the darkness. God is still calling. Will young men and women listen to His call? Pray that they say YES!


