Behavior changes when one recognizes eternity.



Our Catholic Faith By Fr. Bob Regan

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, to the close of the age." Matthew 28:19-20

Over the course of the next few months, we will occasionally use this space in the bulletin to more directly answer specific questions and concerns regarding the unification of St. Rene and St. Symphorosa into a new parish. Please pray that we all approach this unification with minds set on Christ and hearts on fire for mission.

Item #1 – I heard St. Rene got closed. Is that true?

Answer – No! It's not true. The legalistic canonical wording of the Renew My Church decision was easily misinterpreted by some media types and folks from the neighborhood. St. Rene is NOT closing. Although the St. Symphorosa campus has been designated as the location of the office and church sacramental records, this does not mean the St. Rene campus is closing. The newly unified parish will offer two worship sites – the St. Rene campus and the St. Sym's campus. A certain number of Masses will be held at each worship site.

Item #2 – What about any debt? How will that be handled?

Answer – Cardinal Cupich wants all newly unified parishes focused on mission out of the gate, and does not want debt to hold back this task. Although the debt will not totally be excused, the debt must be paid off in the future. However, the debt will need to be paid off with future asset sales from the original parish that had the debt. A percentage of the asset sale will go to pay off the debt while another percentage will remain in the parish for the mission. Weekly collection money for the new parish will NOT be going toward paying off old debt. As of February 2020, St. Rene Goupil has little debt on the books other than an old payroll loan.

Item #3 – When will a pastor be appointed as the shepherd of the new parish?

Answer – We can expect a final decision from the priest placement board and Cardinal Cupich by early to mid-March 2020.

Item #4 – Why are we even doing this whole Renew My Church thing?

Answer – Six years ago, our archbishop quickly surveyed the landscape of the entire archdiocese and saw what many had already been seeing for years – we need a major renewal on two fronts: the property/building side, and the spiritual side.

Instead of simply closing targeted parishes overnight without any local input, Cardinal Cupich launched Renew My Church. Every single parish in the archdiocese is involved in this process. He asked for an honest evaluation of each parish in the areas of finance, buildings, schools and spiritual life.

This is a challenging but necessary undertaking so that we can be responsible stewards of our property all the while reminding ourselves of the vital necessity of evangelization (which is sharing the Good News of Christ with those around us).

We need to address the challenges of today with the realities of today. Simply wishing it were still 1950 doesn't help the cultural climate we face in 2020. We live in a post-Christian society. We live in a society where many folks believe they no longer need God, and most certainly no longer need organized religion.

We as committed disciples think differently. Our culture needs God just as every culture has needed God throughout human history. Jesus gave us the Church as the sacrament of salvation. Within Her graces are bestowed for our good. Our mission is still the same. Share Christ with the world, even when they claim, "Keep your faith to yourself." Jesus' tells us differently. He says, "Go ... make disciples." And so we shall!




